Nearly 800 men and women from Curwensville and the surrounding area served their Country during World War II. As a community Curwensville has yet to honor those men and women with a Memorial. It is time we recognize the sacrifices of all those who have bravely served our Country during World War II. Soon all of our living World War II Veterans will no longer be with us. It is important to construct a Memorial that honors the living as well as deceased Veterans of World War II.

As members of the Curwensville World War II Memorial Committee, we are committed to raising funds to construct a Memorial that will recognize all World War II Veterans from Curwensville and the surrounding area. The Memorial will be constructed of sandstone from a local quarry, with each of the 800 men and women's names inscribed on plaques attached to the sandstone.

In appreciation, a paver will be inscribed with the name, of any individual, company, or organization that contributes \$1,000 or more toward the Memorial. In addition for a contribution of \$5000 or more your name will be inscribed on one of the large landscape stones.
